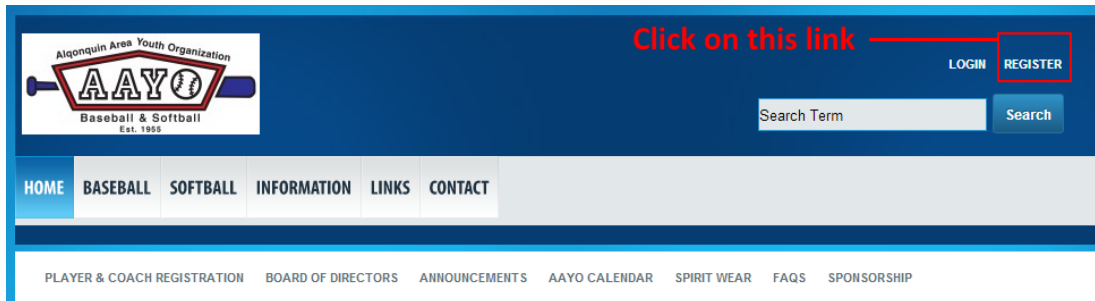


How to register on AAYO.net

STEP 1

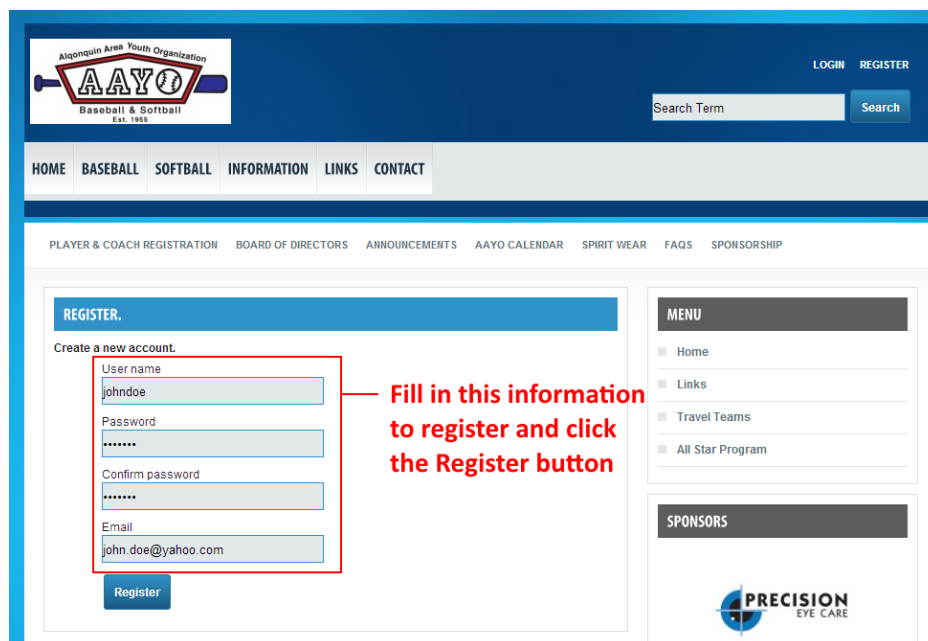
Visit www.aayo.net and click on the Register link at the top right corner of the page.



STEP 2

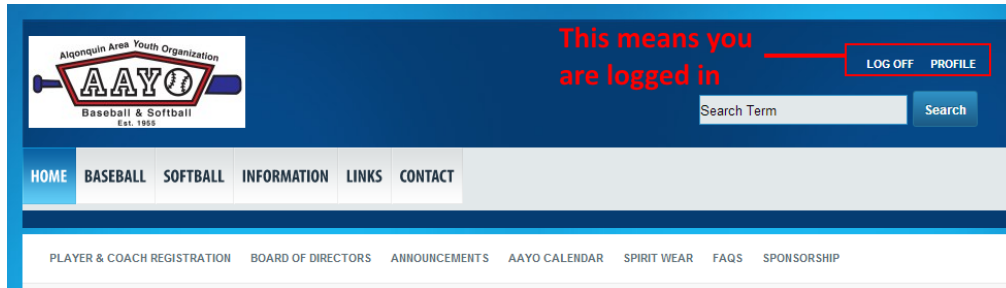
Fill in the Registration form with the following information:

- **Username** – Alpha Numeric text with no special characters
- **Password** – Can be a combination of letters, numbers and special characters
- **Confirm Password** – Repeat entering the password you entered in the password field to confirm you didn't type something other than what you were trying to type in the password field.
- **Email** – Either you're private or AAYO email address goes here.



STEP 3

Once you hit the register button you will be redirected to the aayo.net home page, and you will see a “Log Off” and “Profile” field at the top of the page:



This means that you are now both registered and logged into the website!

Log Off – Will log you out of the website completely.

Profile – Allows you to enter additional information in your user profile. If you click on the profile link, you will see the following page:

You can enter the following information into your user profile:

- Change email
- Enter Birthday
- Add Address, City, State, Zip and Country
- Add a Signature to your Profile
- Upload a picture of yourself as an Avatar. This will be used on the future comment system

If you click on the “Change Password” link at the bottom of the page, it will take you to another form where you can change your password to something else.
